## The Bright Side

*Parent Literacy Convention to Take Place in October; Bishop Hired as Head Football Coach, Positive Outlook on Building New Schools*

PERTH AMBOY – During the public portion of the 7/24/14 Board of Education Meeting resident Junior Inglesia was glad to see that a Parent Literacy Convention was on the agenda. The event is scheduled to take place at the Richardson School on Saturday, October 11, 2014. “It’s the start of building a relationship with community members.” The Literacy Convention is aimed at grades PreK – 4th.

Interim Superintendent Dr. Vivian Rodriguez stated that the district committee will include volunteers and teachers.

Teacher Diane Crawford said that although the event is targeted for PreK – 4<sup>th</sup> Grades, anyone PreK – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade can be involved.

“We are expecting a large number of parents to attend the event,” said Inglesia. He wanted to know if the event could be moved to the High School because the building could accommodate more people and has better parking.

Board Member Milady Tejada suggested Our Lady of Fatima parking lot near the Richardson School would be available if there are no services at the time of the Conference. (With permission from the Church)

Also on the agenda was the hiring of athletic coaches, including the football coaches, and the appointment of Head Football Coach Brad Bishop. Board Member Ken Puccio praised the choice of Bishop, “Many former players are now coaches. Coach Bishop played (for PAHS).” The vote was unanimous among the Board Members on the hiring of Bishop.

Bishop came up to the podium and thanked everyone. “A lot of them (football coaches) have gone to PAHS. It’s a dream of mine to be Head Coach. I already wore

## A Tour of the Venetian Care & Rehabilitation Center The Next Generation State of the Art Facility in Health Care for the Aging, Disabled and Those Needing Rehabilitation

SOUTH AMBOY - The Amboy Guardian was privy to a tour of the newly built Venetian Care & Rehabilitation Center. Windsor Healthcare owns the new Venetian Center and nine other “nursing homes” across New Jersey.

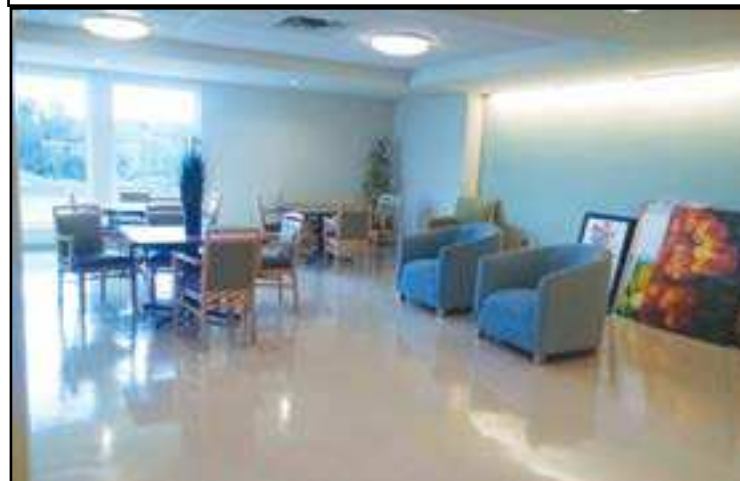
Windsor holds the highest ranking in Nursing Home excellence. President and CEO Hyman Jacobs owns Windsor Healthcare, a family run organization. 3 of his 5 children make Windsor the success that it is. Jacobs built facilities like Venetian on the premise to change the culture of the concept of a nursing home. The facility is based on the principles of: Honor Dignity and Respect. “We want to de-institutionalize institutional life,” states Batsheva Katz, one of the 3 children who are Vice-Presidents of Windsor Healthcare Communities, along with siblings Michael and Joshua Jacobs.

“It took 6 years to find a place (to build),” states Michael Jacobs. “One of the many reasons South Amboy was chosen was because of the location near the waterfront and the pleasant view (available from every room).”

When one enters the Venetian Facility, the first thing noticeable is the warm colors, high ceilings and welcoming atmosphere. “We’re a Kessler #1 rated company,” states Katz. There are 180 beds - 120 beds for long term care and 60 beds for sub-acute (short term rehabilitative care). The facility is open 365 days a year/7 days a week/24 hours a day. There are between 200 - 250 employees.

With 6 elevators and 4 floors (3 floors for patient residency) Venetian offers a state of the art facility. The patient rooms are large, and the walls are 3/4 length of the room between rooms for privacy. Each room is equipped with Wi-Fi, television, controlled temperature. Showers are private so residents can choose where to bathe rather than keeping to a schedule dictated by staff.

This also goes for waking up, going to bed and mealtimes. Not finalized yet, patients may be able to bring their pets (within reason) to help with their comfort. The “wings” in the facility are known as “neighborhoods” where social interaction is encouraged. Each neighborhood is built like a home and has a kitchen in which residents can cook a meal if they choose to. The specialized stove allows cooking without a flame so the patient can’t accidentally burn him/herself on a pot. Patients in neighborhoods are given caregivers and that caregiver will stay with those patients for the duration of the patient’s stay at the facility. The care given is patient specific personalized care - not a one for all situations as in

many nursing homes.

Amenities will include libraries, an exercise/physical therapy room and hospitality based treatment. There is a gift shop, a non-denominational chapel/meditation room and recreational areas. There will even be a garden with a Koi pond. This garden is modeled after the award winning most innovative garden in a nursing home in the United States in Merwick, Princeton (Another Windsor Facility). There will be a gallery featuring local artists with rotating exhibits.

"We do everything we can to encourage life," Katz states. Patients can choose to eat in their rooms or in a bistro style restaurant downstairs. "We have eliminated trays and institutionalized style eating. The patients are served as in a restaurant." There will be a hot/cold food station for each patient's enjoyment.

"This is their home," Katz states. "We offer a convivium

Board Member Dianne Roman stated, "We have to prove ourselves as a district to have a force. The state won't just give us \$200 million. We have to do the groundwork to lay a foundation so the State will take us seriously."

Board Member Maria Garcia agreed with Roman, "I believe we don't have the ability to choose the land. The State has been here looking at the land. All of our land is contaminated. There was a piece of land years ago that belonged to the Housing Authority. All of us want a high school. We have to prove ourselves to the state. We are not here to create jobs. We cannot misinform the pub-

lic. I would love to have \$300 million."

Board Member Sam Lebreault disagreed, "Perth Amboy is the only district in the state that has to prove ourselves? (If this is so) We're doomed. It's not getting better. More and more kids are coming in. There is a land we're interested in. Mr. Jess has already committed a company to evaluate the land."

Board Secretary Derek Jess, "Over the past year, the SDA (School Development Authority) has planned on building a new Elementary School on Seaman Street. We own the property. The State will not clean it. If we clean it, the SDA will build it."

Jess continued, "As far as the high school, we do not have eminent domain - if we want

(living together in good company)."

Residents can enjoy activities in abundance including being transported (in the summer) to the waterfront concerts, summer barbecues and plenty to do all year long. For patients needing physical rehabilitation (such as learning to walk again), all sorts of surfaces (e.g. sand, dirt, sidewalks, etc.) are provided for the patient to walk properly and prepared when released.

When Hyman Jacobs was asked why he built Venetian and other facilities like it, he stated, "I wanted to do something different with the highest level of quality. I believe we were able to achieve it. You start with how you treat your staff - then the staff is empowered. We like to grow from within."

Venetian is based on patient satisfaction. In the preliminary stages of building the entire facility's staff (at other Windsor facilities) - everyone from nurses down to maintenance were asked what was needed

to improve nursing home care, whether it be where the garbage is disposed of or patient comfort - any input was welcome.

One example is there are no florescent lights, an annoying staple in many institutions.

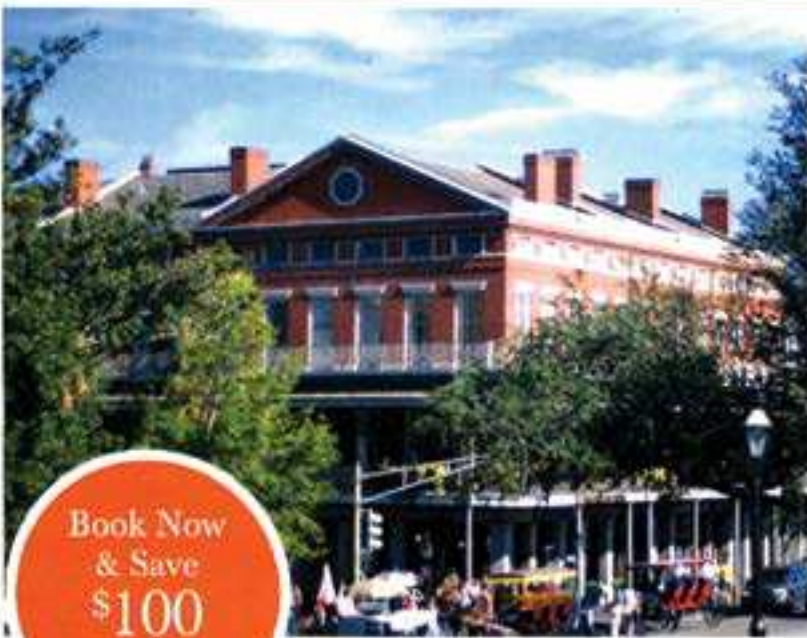
"We are a restraint free organization: both physical and psychological," Katz states proudly, "Windsor views the use of psychiatric drugs as form of restraint."

Windsor Healthcare Communities owns Briarwood Nursing Home (formerly Carriage House). "Briarwood is going to be demolished," states Michael Jacobs. Many of the patients at Briarwood are being transferred to Venetian as are most of the staff."

Venetian offers all type of internships from high school level to higher levels of education. "All sorts of teaching takes place here," Jacobs states. There can be light at the end of a dark tunnel and Pastor Berny Falcon-Lopez is a testament to that.

Pastor Berny Falcon-Lopez was the keynote speaker at the 18<sup>th</sup>/19<sup>th</sup> Century Victorian Tea held at the Knights of Columbus on 7/20/14. This event was a fundraiser for the Perth Amboy Domestic Violence Response Team.

Each time I’ve seen Pastor Berny, she always has a smile on her face and a pleasant disposition. You would never guess the hardships she endured as a child and then becoming a teen mother. She spoke about the abuse at the hands of her father and her first husband. Growing up she witnessed her father beating her mother and threatening her mom with a knife.

When Pastor Berny was eleven years old, she could not understand why her mom abandoned the family. She later learned that her mom was institutionalized for a nervous breakdown and her mother went back to live with her mother (Pastor Berny’s grandmother)

Pastor Berny recalled how she ran away several times to live with her mom an grandmother only to be dragged back home to endure more violence at the hands of her dad.

She was eventually able to move in with her mother and grandmother. Her self esteem had taken a low blow and she married a man who was just as destructive as her father.

She became a mother at the age of 16. In spite of her father’s abuse, she became her father’s caretaker when he became gravely ill.

After her father’s death, she needed to be close to her mom and other relatives that relocated to New Jersey. She begged her husband if she can go. When he finally relented, he gave her a one-way ticket to New Jersey and told her she could not take the kids with her.

When she was finally able to return to Chicago where she and her husband lived, he told her that he wanted a divorce. She said she wasn’t surprised because she knew her husband had already replaced her with someone else. She finally had the strength to stand up to him and with her children in tow, she moved to New Jersey.

In the photo above is Pastor Berny with her new love and husband, Pastor Raul. She has 3 children who have made her very proud.

She is an example of that light that shines at the end of a long dark tunnel. That light is within you. C.M.

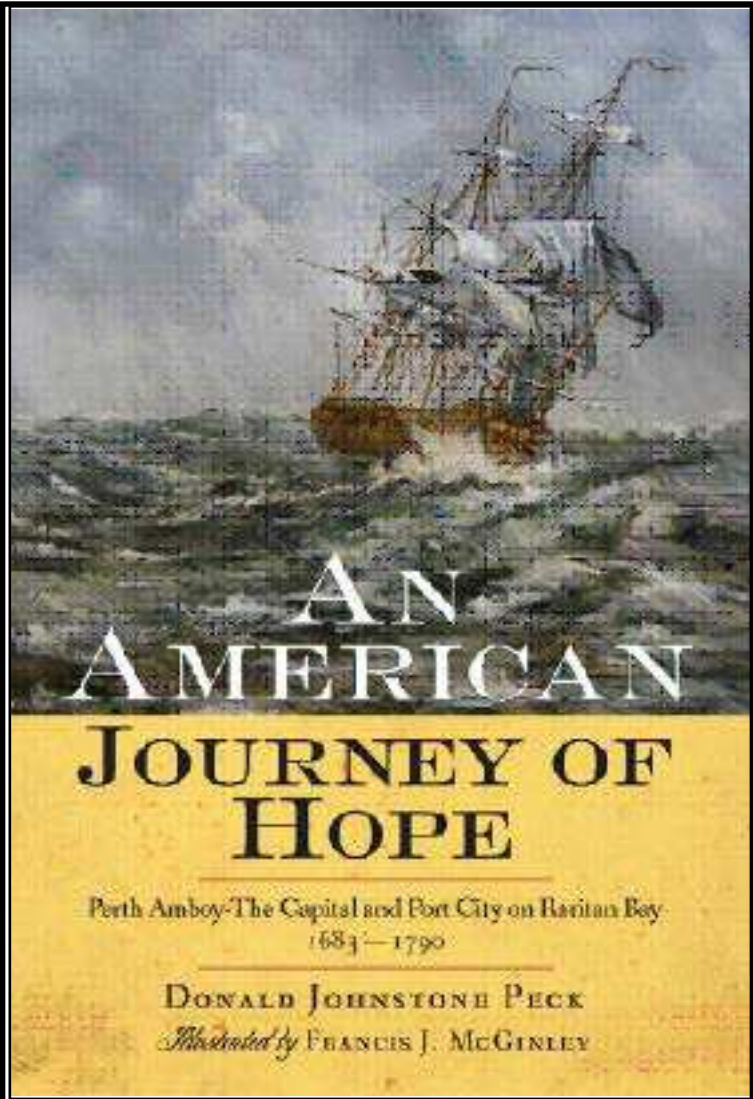
