PERTH AMBOY - Thursday, September 13 at 3 p.m. was the last chance for any candidate who qualified to be placed on the ballot to drop out if they so desired. None did. City Clerk Elaine Jasko told those assembled at the Council Chambers that the ballot box being used to pull out the candidates names for positions was returned to the City yesterday (September 12, 2012).

This is the same ballot box that was used when Tony Jones name was pulled in a housing scheme that former Mayor Joe Vas was involved in. Jones was awarded a house that he was not eligible for. Jones (Vas' former driver). Jones pleaded guilty in connection with a scheme involving him and Vas to rig a public housing lottery.

Jasko had seven index cards with the candidates names on them. Mayoral candidate and

their runningmates were listed on the same card.

One Council candidate, James F. Aleck had his name listed individually on an index card. Jasko invited the candidates or their representatives to look at the index cards placed on the railing in front of the Council Chambers. She cautioned everyone "Look, but please do not touch the cards."

She scolded one person who touched the card and that person committed that infraction gently placed the card back in place with her elbow.

After the examination Jasko folded each card in half and placed them in the infamous ballot box. Jasko also brought a chuckle to the crowd when she said, "I purposely wore tions on the same day." short sleeves for this event."

She spun the box backwards, and forwards before pulling each name. The names came out in this order: Pos

Jasko will forward this information to Middlesex County Clerk Elaine Flynn. Flynn will be the one assigning the letters and numbers to each candi-

The County Clerk will be having a special class for poll clerks to familiarize themselves with the ballots.

Jasko stated, "This is the first time in my many years as the City Clerk that we've had the General, Municipal and School Board elec-

Each candidate was given a fifty-three page election ordinance booklet for 2012 pre-

Mixing It Up Council Meeting 9/12/12

PERTH AMBOY - Local resident Ron Mascenik addressed the Council in regards to the Perth Amboy redevelopment agency minutes not appearing on the City website. He was concerned because all other Perth Amboy Municipal Board meetings were there. Council President Kenneth Balut said, "The server had been hacked on Monday."

After Mascenik spoke, resident John Siberry addressed Councilman Joel Pabon in regards to what Siberry referred to as a legal junkyard on Kearny Avenue. Siberry was referring to a resident, Maria Garcia who is the Chair of the Planning Board. He said, "There are many cars in that resident's backyard," and he believes that there has been an illegal business being conducted there for the past five years.

The reason that Siberry brought this to Pabon's attention is because he lives about four houses down from the residence in question.

Councilman Pabon said, "I personally don't go into anybody's backyard. Her neighbor's are okay with her back-

Joel Pabon stated that the situation on Kearny Avenue was looked into by Code Enforcement.

Maria Garcia has appeared at Council Meetings in the past to address this issue. She said that she was in compliance with the City ordinances.

Local resident Stanley Sierakowski and Mayoral Candidate Billy Delgado also voiced their concerns about the situation. Stanley agreed with Sibbery about the amount of cars in Garcia's backyard and Delgado said that there is a possibility that she is "skirting the law."

Fernando Gonzalez interjected that, "It is illegal to create a parking space in front of your house such as parking on the sidewalk and we were not enforcing codes across the board. I was looking through our ordinances for anything pertaining to junkyards and we have none. Residents are selectively being picked on when it comes to enforcing ordinances."

Council President Balut said, "I've turned numerous photos and reports to Code Enforcement and to Attorney General showing properties with code violations. I've even taken the Attorney General in person to show him some of these properties."

Councilman Kenneth Gonzalez remembered when people have come before the Council to complain that the fines were too high for code violations.

Another lengthy discussion occured when Tommy Hudanish questioned the salaries of the Business Administrator and City Attorney. "Why are we paying such high salaries to people who are not City

Spots and cocktail blues are dominating the action off the piers using a small piece of worm or a small piece of fish bites make spots a easy catch. Peanut bunker been doing their dance along the piers with cocktail blues giving chase and weakfish underneath. Some of the old salts using a small treble hook snag them then live line them with great success. While others use spearing and poppers or small lures with just as good results.

This week quit a few nice looking fluke were brought into the shop caught on spearing and killies so they're still plenty to be caught by season's



end, September 28th.

Weakfish action also been doing well the best in years caught on peanut bunkers worms and squid the regulations are 13" 1 fish per person.

So where are the porgys?

Porgys normally start coming in the second to third week of September reports of monster porgys are coming in from the second rock pile by the 20 can high lo rigs and fresh sand worms been doing the trick.

Sea bass though not common to have great size locally have been caught at the rock piles and wrecks as well with a few keeper size.

Stripers - schoolies been making their runs, the night shift has been catching them on worms. shoolies = throw back, using circle hooks ensure a safer release.

I recently overheard someone say if the striper fits in the pan they're taking it. My response was remember we fish because we enjoy it the thrill of the hunt the action of the fight the relaxation of the water the hope of catching the big one. We all have our reasons why we love the sport so much for me its therapeutic. In this day and age were not fishing to survive (if you are then inquire about government assistance because man you're in trouble) We fish to relax to getaway for awhile and most of all have fun. Taking undersize fish is wrong and fines are not cheap. Giving away shorts is not any better than keeping it yourself. It's a touchy subject but one that needed to be addressed.






