Memorial Day: Honoring Those Who Made the Ultimate Sacrifice

COLONIA - Died January 19, 2012 Serving During Operation Enduring Freedom 25, of Colonia; assigned to Marine Heavy Helicopter Squadron 363, Marine Aircraft Group 24, 1st Marine Aircraft Wing, III MEF, Kaneohe Bay, Hawaii; died Jan. 19 in Helmand province, Afghanistan, when the CH-53D helicopter he was riding in crashed.

PERTH AMBOY - Sgt. Sadowski as a tank commander was advancing with the leading elements through a severe barrage of enemy fire from the streets and buildings of the town of Valhey. As his tank advanced it was struck by a shell from an 88-mm gun fired at a range of 20 yds and burst into flames. Sgt. Sadowski immediately ordered his crew to dismount and take cover in the adjoining buildings. After his crew had dismounted, Sergeant Sadowski discovered that one member of the crew, the bow gunner, had been unable to leave the tank. Although the tank was being subjected to a withering hail of enemy small-arms, bazooka, grenade, and mortar fire from the streets and from the windows of adjacent buildings, He unhesitatingly returned to his tank and tried to pry up the bow gunner's hatch. While engaged in this attempt to rescue his comrade from the burning tank, he was cut down by a stream of machine-gun fire which resulted in his death. The gallant and noble sacrifice of his life in the aid of his comrade, undertaken in the face of almost certain death, so inspired the remainder of the tank crews that they pressed forward with great ferocity and completely destroyed the enemy forces in the town without further loss to themselves. Sgt. Sadowski earned The Medal of Honor posthumously During WWII for heroism September 14, 1944 at Valhey, France.




It turned out the mission was an offensive one, and Petach could have refused it, as he remained with the group for the purpose of air dome defense, but he volunteered. He went in on a dive bombing run, let loose his havoc on the Japanese gunboat, then suddenly was in trouble-his ship went down and he was killed. The pilot who flew on his wing said Petach's bomb hit the target but at the same instant his plane exploded, apparently hit by ground fire.

Garbage, Litter Discussed in South Amboy

 SOUTH AMBOY - Litter problems and the amended garbage ordinance were both discussed at last Wednesday's South Amboy city council meeting.

Resident Michael Hegarty of 228 Augusta Street brought his concerns about the litter in town to the council during the meeting's public session. He explained that people who purchase food and drinks from local businesses are leaving garbage in alleys and streets all over town.

"The alley ways, especially the alley way between 2nd and Main Street, are disgusting," Hegarty said. "If you walk that alley way [between 2nd and Main] there's got to be a couple thousand of those little shots of booze, all kinds of litter and bottles, flattened cans... it looks terrible."

Council President Mickey Gross asked Business Administrator Camille Tooker to take note of the problem and speak with the code enforcer to look into the alley way situation.

Hegarty also brought an unsolicited ad newspaper that is constantly thrown on his lawn and throughout South Amboy. He noted that most of these papers either get thrown away or wind up in a storm drain and the ads don't represent businesses in South Amboy.

"I don't want to see this but I can't stop it...I don't want this litter," he said. "People have 10 or 15 of these on their front porch soaking wet looking terrible. I'd like the council to try

and address this."

Mayor Fred Henry noted that the city has had issues with these paper companies before but the city will reach out again to follow up. Council President Gross, who worked code enforcement for over 30 years, noted that it is very difficult to deal with a situation like this but the city will look into it.

An ordinance amending the city's garbage codes was added to the agenda on Wednesday as well. If adopted the changes would include extending the time to remove garbage cans from the curb from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. and fining first time violators \$75 rather than making them go to court for a first offense.

Despite these changes, resident Stan Jankowski of 135 John Street was concerned more about the time that residents have to wait to put their garbage out. Currently residents are not allowed to put out their garbage cans on the curb until 8:00 p.m. the night before the pick-up date, which Jankowski thought was unfair to the city's senior citizens.

"People nowadays are older and more senior like," he said. "To ask a person who goes to bed at 7:00 p.m. to wait until 8:00 p.m. to put out their garbage is totally ridiculous."

Mayor Henry noted that the ordinance was only up on first reading so there was still time for the council to go back and review the garbage codes. He also clarified that Jankowski was asking to amend a part of

the code that was not included in this ordinance's changes.

Another part of the garbage codes that raised concerns was the section that requires residents to store their garbage receptacles in the back of their property. An on-going issue has been residents and business owners getting fined for keeping their receptacles on the front or side of their building.

"You're asking people that are up in age to put their garbage in the backyard and lug it up at eight at night," Jankowski said. "Nine months out of the year it's dark at 8:00 p.m. and you're going to have them lug all their garbage out [in the dark]...God forbid someone is hurt...they are going to look up this ordinance and say 'they made me do it'."

Mayor Henry explained that the city continues to look into this section of the garbage codes as well. He recognized that there are some businesses and homes that logistically cannot store their receptacles behind the building and that storing them on the side as far back as possible would suffice.

"We are looking for people to move it away from the front of the house," he said. "If it's on the side toward the back and it's kept neat I don't think we have a major problem with that."

All members of the council were in attendance for the meeting. South Amboy will hold the monthly business meeting on June 3rd at 6:00 p.m.

Many people will intertwine Memorial Day with Veteran's Day. The only similarities are: they all served. There is a big difference. Those that we remember on Memorial Day final homecoming was in a casket.

the freedoms and the pay given to men at the time. Some just wanted to serve because they believe in the cause of their side. Only when these women were wounded in the war were their true identities discovered. Some hid their identities so well that it wasn't until they gave birth a few months later that their true gender was revealed. Like their male counterparts, some of them made the ultimate sacrifice.

To make the conscience choice to voluntarily serve is to be commended.

Unfortunately with an all volunteer military, a person can be called for multiple deployments. Each of these deployments can cause a physical and mental strain that is unimaginable. This takes a toll on family members as well.

A prayer is said each time this is done and anytime there's a United States Casualty report. Families of someone serving in the military are holding a collective breath. They are saying, "Please don't let it be me who they'll be calling or walking up to my door to say, 'I'm so sorry to inform you of the loss of...'"

I cannot imagine the anguish of the person hearing the bad news.

On Veteran's Day, we honor all who served. On Memorial Day we need to make a very conscious effort to realize the loss not only felt by the family members and friends, but it's a loss felt by us all as one nation.

It is our wish that we could pay homage to all of our fallen soldiers, but the best that we can do is give a few shining examples to represent them all. We encourage everyone to honor those on Memorial Day in their towns who have made the ultimate sacrifice.

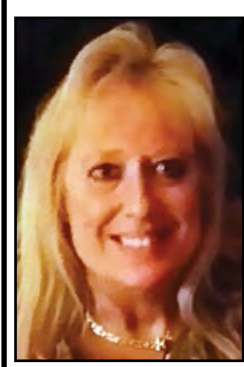



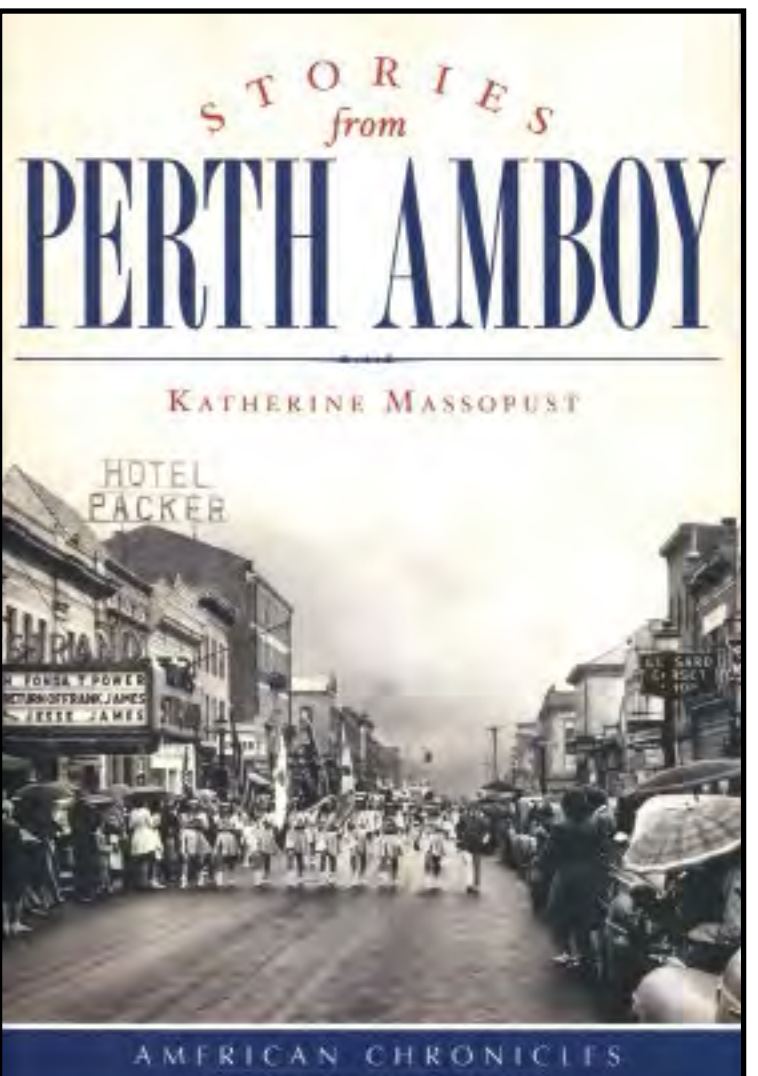
