New Interim Business Administrator Comes Under Fire; He Fires Back Residents Still Question Out-of-Town Hirees





PERTH AMBOY - At the 10/14/15 Caucus Portion of the Council Meeting, Resident Stanley Sierakowski asked a barrage of questions directed toward Council President Lisa Nanton in reference to the new Interim Business Administrator. Sierakowski read an article from 2007 that questioned the Interim B.A. Peter Pelissier's pension when he was employed by the City of Rahway, retired from that job and then came back as a consultant.

Sierakowski read the letter in its entirety. A summary of the

blog opinion piece is as follows: A person cannot collect a pension and simultaneously hold a job that is covered by the same retirement system in which he is collecting the pension. The article also faults Rahway Officials who allowed this.

Former Council President Ken Balut wondered, "Why do we always have the lawyers from the DeCotlis law firm? Everyone is connected to this firm. Did we hire the lawyer or the firm? We make appointments of people who were in-

volved in messes before. The poor people living in this town are paying for the lifestyles of these people (who live out-oftown)."

After Balut spoke, two attorneys came up to speak. Carlos Bollar from the law firm of Archer & Greiner spoke in support of Acting Law Director Arlene Quinones Perez. He also said that he would be the President of the Hispanic Bar Association in thirteen days. He touted her, "She is an out-

Mayor Diaz Appoints New Interim Administrator

"He is a professional, a veteran and an experienced administrator who will work with my administration and the City Council to best serve our residents and taxpayers. His extensive knowledge, skill-set and integrity will also provide much value to our continued business growth in Perth Am-

boy."

Peter Pelissier has served the public as a Professional City Administrator for more than 30 years, most notably working for the City of Rahway, as Director of Administration and Business Administrator for over 20 years. He also served as the Executive Director of the Rahway Redevelopment Agency from its inception in 2001 until his retirement in 2014. Under his direction, the City of Rahway brought in millions of tax dollars due to a tremendous increase of tax ratables.

His most notable achievement was negotiating one of the first Public/Private part-

nerships in the State of New Jersey, to provide water services, saving over \$32 million throughout the duration of a 20-year agreement. During his tenure, he had reorganized city departments, streamlined city business systems, improved customer service and elevated professionalism of local government through the City of Rahway's Core Values: Teamwork, Integrity, Innovation, and Professionalism.

Mr. Pelissier's other municipal experience includes, being the clerk and administrator for Long Hill Township; Adminis-

SOUTH AMBOY - Today, October 14, 2015 at 0816 hrs, the City of South Amboy Fire Department was dispatched to the area of 424 Parker Avenue for a reported smell of natural gas in the area. The initial alarm alerts all five of the city's companies as well as the city's fire police to respond. Fire Fighter and Fire Police Officer Gerald "Bear" Celecki was in performance of his duties directing traffic when he sustained an unknown medical emergency. Fire fighters on the scene immediately initiated CPR. The South Amboy First Aid with the assistance of Raritan Bay Medical Center Paramedics quickly arrived on scene and continued to provide lifesaving care. Mr. Celecki was transported to Raritan Bay Medical Center in Perth Amboy but ultimately succumbed



standing attorney with integrity. Our membership of the Hispanic Bar Association of New Jersey supports her. Her reputation is impeccable and she is an inspiration and role model to young attorneys."

Resident David Caba still had questions and he addressed Councilman Fernando Gonzalez, "At what point was Quinones Perez qualified? Since 2009, when she graduated from law school she has held seven jobs. The longest one was nine months. And you did research in one day? You did not vote for Fehrenbach (Former B.A.) who had forty years of experience because he was not a resident. We have all these people who don't live here that came up to speak and they didn't give their address. The Mayor from Clinton came here to tell us how to vote. They don't contribute to our town or see what goes on here."

Councilman Fernando Gonzalez responded to Caba, "In life we say many things. I prefer to have someone who lives here, but she (Quinones Perez) is qualified."

Resident Alan Silber came up to speak after Gonzalez made his comments, "A lot of outof-towners came up here and not one gave their address. We should know where these outof-towners live. When I come

up to speak, I gave my full address. Everyone knows where I live. Having two meetings in one day is not working. It's on the books. It's the Open Meetings Act. There were all these announcements about the new Law Director, but none about the new Acting B.A. The public has a right to know about this important position. We need the best we can get. I saw Blunda (Former Law Director) battle and win decisions against four attorneys from the other side. Ouinones said that she is part politician and part lawyer. I wonder how long she will be here."

Resident Reinaldo Aviles said, "No one is questioning Quinones' credentials. Maybe she should have worked with Blunda like Barrick did under Fehrenbach."

After everyone spoke re-

garding both positions, Interim B.A. Pelissier fired back, "Welcome, to Perth Amboy." He addressed then first speaker (Sierakowski). "I want to address the first speaker. You don't know how to do research very well."

At that point Sierakowski interrupted Pelissier, but Pelisser continued, "I did not interrupt you when you were speaking. Now, I'm speaking to everyone. That article (the blog) was an opinion. You should do more research. There was no complaint. There was a reveiw. The Treasury Department did a review on my post retirement from the City of Rahway. There were no violations. This was after the Pension Board asked for a reconsideration because they were not sure how

Council Meeting 10/14/15 Questioning Continues Over New Hirees & Old Issues Revisited

PERTH AMBOY - During the 10/14/15 Council Meeting arguments continued on both sides as to the Mayor's appointments.

Resident Peter Perez said, "So much negativity occurs whenever the Mayor hires anyone. They are just against the Mayor. If you don't like what the Mayor is doing, then don't vote for her. The negativity has to stop."

Resident Alan Silber pointed out, "Look at the Mayor's record of appointees. She hired Former Business Administrator of Trenton Jane Feigenbaum. That didn't work out. We were supposed to have a county park. Now it's only going to be for the Vocational School's use. Councilman Fernando Gonzalez said he wouldn't vote for someone with forty plus years of experience because they didn't live in town? Now it's no problem. Irizarry and Nanton should be congratulated. I watched the last Council Meeting on TV. It was unbelievable."

Resident David Caba said, "I supported Diaz in 2008. She said she would only run for two terms. Now she's

running for a third term. She has no credibility. I also supported Pabon in 2010. This is not a matter of race. It's a matter of integrity and doing the right thing for the taxpayers who live here. We have to go to Montana to get an Interim B.A. Did anyone contact the Passaic Dominican Mayor for suggestions? You don't need a degree to be a Business the ordinance on that. You couldn't find someone locally that's qualified for this position?"

Former Council Member Ken Balut was surprised that the Interim Business Administrator would threaten to sue a citizen that was reading something from a newspaper article. "Did you sue anyone who wrote this newspaper article?" Balut also wondered how someone can get a pension after being in a position for only 31 months. "All of our business administrators that we had before never threatened the citizens. People from out of town get a huge amount of money from our taxpayers, then go back to their own towns. I will find out more. Why is the Mayor hiring

people with grey areas in their backgrounds?"

Resident Sharon Hubberman to the mic to express concerns about double dipping which is an ongoing problem. "When you're looking to fill a permanent position for the Business Administrator, there are a lot qualified people who are not already collecting a pension."

Attorney and Perth Amboy Administrator? I will check Democratic Chair Billy Delgado came forward to praise the new Acting Business Administrator. He also had advice for some of the people who criticized the Mayor's choice. "People just suppose all the time without sitting down to talk with the person. I've looked at his (Pelissier) record when he worked for other towns. I apologize for the people who come up here and have been insulting. I've seen what you've done in Rahway. Other towns joke about Perth Amboy. I hope your wife is not too upset about you taking this job. I hope people can see what you can do to help the City. We want professionals who can help the City and raise a level and the reputation of the City."



A Perth Amboy Treasure Who Left Many Lasting Memories Behind

Perth Amboy lost another true treasure recently. During the Council Meeting held on 10/14/15 a moment of silence was observed in tribute to Tom Ward and also Mrs. Marie Petrick, mother of Councilman Bill Petrick. Council President Lisa Nanton became very emotional as she spoke about Ward not only as a friend, but for his service as a Board Member of the Proprietary House and on Municipal Boards. One person at the Council Meeting mentioned that the City should lower the flag at half-staff for Tom Ward. The City did so on 10/16/15.

The first time I was aware of Tom Ward was when he was an honoree at the Ides of March Dinner for his contributions to the City. He was recognized for his artwork and devotion to Perth Amboy history. If you ever visited the Prop House or eaten at the Barge Restaurant and admired some of the paintings on the wall or the murals, you've seen his artwork. On the outside of Bayside Creamery there is also a mural painted by Tom Ward. These are only a few of his many works.

When Wilda Diaz became Mayor of Perth Amboy, she commissioned Tom Ward to paint a mural in the official office of the Mayor to depict many of the historical sites in Perth Amboy. On the Market side of the entrance to City Hall, as soon as you walk into the foyer on the left hand side of the staircase, there is another of Ward's artistic render-

ings.

Each year the Royal Garden Club conducts tours of historical homes that are showcased on High Street and Water Street. Many of those homes had murals painted by Tom Ward also depicting scenes from Perth Amboy.

Sometimes it's not necessary to go inside of these homes to view the murals by Ward, because some of the garages and other exteriors of the homes have drawings by Ward. Some of them are of flowers like Council President Lisa Nanton's home on Gordon Street.

Ward's talents not only included drawings but he could also build things such as the doll house depicted above. He also painted landscapes. He also has lent his talents to restore pieces in the Propriety House and in some of the local churches

Some of Tom Ward's artwork is displayed in this issue and will be displayed in future ones. He joins his wife, Betty who passed away in July of this year. *C.M.*



The committee will be tasked to discuss some topics, including:


