

Hazardous Conditions Discussed at Meeting

PERTH AMBOY - 9/21/15 Caucus Meeting - Code Enforcement Officer Jamie Rios sat with the Council to answer questions pertaining to conditions in the outside area of the Armory Restaurant.

"The fire pit is under violation due to underground gas lines. The Armory removed al aluminum tables and chairs from the outside. The owners are trying to get variances to enclose some of the outside areas."

Acting Chief Larry Cattano came forward to address another issue at the Armory, "There is a consumption of alcohol on the right-a-way and the property that belongs to the City. Off duty Police are there to make sure this doesn't hap- own the manhole covers. I'm

pen. Signage has to be placed stating that alcohol is not to be consumed beyond this point."

Amboy Avenue was a sore point with Councilman Fernando Gonzalez. Gonzalez was concerned about road conditions on Amboy Avenue, specifically mentioning the address of 914. "Part of the road is caving in. When trucks pass there, houses shake."

Acting Police Chief Larry Cattano came forward and told the Council, "The Sewer Department and Public Works responded to this problem."

Eddie Perez from the Department of Public Works, made additional comments about this problem. Perez stated, "New Jersey Bell and Verizon

on top of the situation. I was on the phone for 4 hours talking to Verizon about this problem (part of Amboy Avenue Road caving in). I will have to talk to the City Engineers about a possible solution in the meantime."

Councilman Bill Petrick commented about the caps on the bulkheads at the City Marina. Coating is missing and the connecting wells are not in working order. I would like to hear from Mainberger (Civil Engineer) about the situation." Robert C. Mainberger is PE, CME, Senior Vice President of Hatch Mott MacDonald. This firm has been doing a lot of the repair work on the City's Marina."

Senators Gill & Vitale Call on Horizon to **Halt New Insurance Plans**

30-Day Moratorium on Horizon OMNIA Plans Will Allow for Public Vetting

News Release 9/24/15 TRENTON - Senators Nia H. Gill and Joseph F. Vitale today sent a letter to Horizon BCBSNJ requesting a 30-day moratorium on the release of the newly-announced OMNIA Alliance insurance plans into the state's marketplace. The delay will allow for a public vetting of the plans at the joint hearing of the Senate Health and Commerce committees scheduled for Oct. 5.

The request by the senators,

sent in a letter to Robert A. Marino, Horizon Chairman, President and Chief Executive Officer, comes after increasing questions about the proposed insurance plans by consumers, health care providers and elected officials.

"The proposal to dramatically change the insurance plans offered by the largest insurer in New Jersey, and the manner in which it was announced, has caused a great deal of confusion and anxiety in consumers and members of the health care community," wrote Senators Vitale and Gill. "Despite the release by Horizon of public relations documents related to the plan, far too many questions remain about how the alliance was developed, the impact the new plans will have on residents and hospitals around the state, and the hidden costs to health care consumers."

"...We request that Horizon suspend for 30 days the release of the new plans into the state's insurance marketplace.

Fire at 775 Chamberlain Ave.




Shown above is damage to a woman's Motorized Wheelchair which is speculated to have started the fire.

PERTH AMBOY - Statement from Perth Amboy Fire Department Chief Abraham Pitre: The Fire Department was dispatched to 775 Chamberlain Ave Apt 4 around 12:17 p.m. for a reported smoke condition called in by a home health aide who was checking on a client. Fire Chief Abraham Pitre arrived on location and the health aide advised him that there was smoke in the apartment and that the resident was still inside the apartment. When Chief Pitre opened the door to the apartment door he encountered heavy smoke and high heat conditions. Chief Pitre attempted to make an entry to locate the resident but encountered fire after entering several feet. Shortly thereafter other fire units arrived on location Chief Pitre grabbed a fire extinguisher as the firefighters got their equipment; Chief Pitre entered the apartment once more and extinguished most of the fire. Crews then entered and removed the 70 year old victim who was located in bed and suffered severe burns. The resident was treated by EMS from Raritan Bay Medical Center and was transported to St. Barnabas Burn Center by helicopter with burns over 50% of her body. The origin of the fire was determined to be on the seat of her motorized wheelchair but the ignition is still undetermined.

Some of the following information was obtained in: Wikipedia, Esquire, Magazine and The Yogi Book.


Yogi Berra had played his most of his career with the NY Yankees (and a brief stint as a player/coach on the NY Mets) then as a Coach and Manager for the Mets then as a Coach and Manager for the Yankees. He wore No. 8 after Yankee Player Bill Dickey. He was first called Yogi by his friend Jack Maguire, who said he resembled a Hindu yogi whenever he sat around with arms and legs crossed waiting to bat or while looking sad after a losing game. Yogi even has a famous cartoon character indirectly named after him (Yogi Bear).

Besides his baseball accomplishments, Yogi Berra served in WWII in the US Navy as a gunner's mate and helped invade Omaha Beach against German defenses. He also helped invade Utah Beach on D-Day.

An online petition that was started by Businessman Steve Forbes to have Yogi awarded the highest Civilian Award: the Presidential Medal of Freedom. The deadline for the need of 100,000 signatures was in early June. This was achieved and the petition was forwarded to the White House. As of this date there is no response.

But we want to talk about Yogi Berra the philosopher. Yogi was famous for his wit and famous sayings. A list of his "yogi-isms" can be found in the book, "The Yogi Book: I Really Didn't Say Everything I Said," by Yogi Berra. In the book, Yogi explains where his famous sayings originated

tired of answering that question." Here Yogi explains that the Yankees weren't doing very well and day after day being drilled by reporters, Yogi answered finally answered them with a yogi-ism. How many times do people ask the same questions over and over again hoping to get a different answer.

"You can observe a lot by watching." Yogi explains that he was yelling at the 1964 Yankees (the players weren't watching the game). Observation is an excellent skill and necessary in almost any area you are working in.

"You've got to be careful if you don't know where you're going 'cause you might not get there." Yogi explains that this meant, "If you don't set goals, you can't regret not reaching them." Very true.

"The future ain't what it used to be." Yogi explains that times are different – not necessarily better or worse. Or as Billy Joel states "The good times weren't always good and now isn't as bad as it seems."

"90% of the Game is half mental." Yogi explains this as a coaching strategy. So true. So many things are best just done following your best instincts and best not to spend ten years analyzing what to do.

"It's deja vu all over again!" Yogi explains that Mickey Mantle and Roger Maris hit back-to-back homeruns for the umpteenth time. "Makes per-





Spreading the Word on Disease, Education, and Community Health

PERTH AMBOY - People who are passionate about public health and disease transmission often dream of being asked to visit the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) in Atlanta, Georgia. This past summer Rebecca Souza, a biology teacher at Perth Amboy High School, was fortunate enough to be invited spend a week at the CDC to work with science experts and with 31 other educators form across the nation to develop classroom material.

The CDC is the agency responsible for the protection and monitoring of health in the United States. As the nation's public health leader, they respond to a variety of health crises (like the Ebola outbreak earlier this year). Each summer, the CDC hosts a weeklong professional development opportunity for select middle and high school math or science educators. The Science Ambassador Program focuses on building and utilizing public health-based lesson plans in the classroom. The purpose is to create students with a genuine interest in population and community health. Prepared students will be able to continue their education at the collegiate level and become the next generation of public

health workers in the U.S., and worldwide.

Program participants:

- Tour selected CDC facilities
- Learn from and interact with CDC scientists
- Participate in multiple sessions on selected topics led by public health professionals
- Work in teams to develop science lesson plans based on public health topics such as West Nile Virus, obesity, autism, smoking and teen dating violence
- Enhance their professional network of teachers and public health scientists
- Present ideas for lesson plans to peers and obtain feedback

The role of CDC Science Ambassador continues long after the week is over. Participants continue work with the CDC experts on the lesson developed at the conference. All lessons are evaluated by CDC education supervisors and the specialists in each specific area. Ambassadors can reapply and return as program alumni to Atlanta and work on case study design, which is used by the CDC to train all Epidemic Intelligence Agents (EIS) for two years previous to deployment.
