

## Municipal ID Programs Discussed

PERTH AMBOY - 12/7/15 Caucus Meeting - Director of the Department of Recreation Kenny Ortiz gave an extensive overview of the importance of Municipal ID's for City Residents.

An information packet was handed out to the members of the Council and a slide show presentation was shown for all to see.

Ortiz stated, "28% of households in the City have no bank accounts compared to 5% overall in Middlesex County. A taskforce was formed consisting of local businesses, banks and social services to address this problem to help our residents. There are fees for the ID cards. We understand that there are some who will not be able to pay for these fees. For these hardship cases, there will be no fees for them or reduced fees. The ID Program will fall under the jurisdiction of the Department of Human Services."

Deputy Chief of Police Larry Cattano came up to speak about this program. "Overall, the program (Municipal ID) will grow. People want to be able to get bank accounts."

Ortiz cautioned, "The ID Cards would only be valid in the City of Perth Amboy. They can be used as one of the points when applying for a driver's license. Businesses will have a decal displayed if they participate in the ID Program. Residents who do have Municipal ID's will able to get a discount at these stores. Homeless people have used social service programs when they are in need. We can go to these different social service organizations and check with them to see if any of these homeless individuals were given assistance."

Ortiz also cautioned that these ID's cannot be used for voting, passports or identification when traveling by air. "These are just some of the restrictions. Newark, New Jersey is one of the cities that has Municipal ID Programs in place."

Councilman Fernando Irizarry was concerned about the following: what kind of information would the applicant have to divulge on the form needed to be filled out? What information would be put on the card? Where would that record be stored?

"How long a time frame will be given to see if this program works out?" Irizarry asked.

Ortiz answered part of the question, "The Art Gallery on the corner of Reade and Fayette Streets would have storage space available where the applications would be stored."

A time frame could not be given by Ortiz if the City decides to abort the program.

At that point, Johanna Calle, a Representative from the NJ Alliance for Immigrant Justice came up to the podium and answered some of the Council's concerns. She stated how successful the program was

in other Municipalities. Calle was familiar with the success rate that the City of the Newark had with this program.

Calle added. "It's important that residents get government ID issues. It can be counted for federal funding.

Councilman Joel Pabon said, "I think it's a great program. They're a lot of sports players that can use these ID's. It's worth a shot. It's a win-win situation."

That was not good enough for some people. Later on in the Meeting, during the public portion Resident Ken Balut stated, "No records are safe."

Pastor Bernadette Falcon-Lopez had a different view and emphasized the importance of Municipal ID's, especially when it comes to the homeless, "They need to have ID's (photos) so they can get services. Food pantries can supply the homeless with emergency food, but without the proper ID, they cannot get registered for the food banks."

## Parking Pay Stations Under Scrutiny

PERTH AMBOY - 12/9/15 Regular Meeting - R-562 -12/15 - Authorizing a contract with Amano Megann Inc. for 13 Solar Parking Pay Stations in an amount no to succeed \$104,613.

Councilman Fernando Gonzalez said, "I received more information from a maintenance man and Interim B.A. that this resolution may be more than just about the Pay Stations.

After Gonzalez spoke, Chet Wilkolaski, a Representative from Amano Mcgann came up to speak to give an overview of the new pay stations and to answer any questions. "The new pay stations are 4-5 generations newer than what you have now. For the first year, you will have a parts warranty. The City (Perth Amboy) technicians will have the first line of maintenance. We are replacing only the pay stations. They run off batteries charged by the sun. The life expectancy of the pay stations are 10-15 years. The new pay stations can run 3 weeks without being charged by the sun. We use specific pay-by-phone companies. It also takes credit cards. You can also pay through your smart phone but you need a contract with specific phone carriers that we work with to do so."

Parking Utility Director Jeanette Rios was very enthusiastic about the solar parking pay stations. "The Pay Stations can report to us in-house if there is a problem."

Councilman Fernando Irizarry had concerns that the Amano Megann is a priority contract

Wilkolaski answered, "We have 40 offices worldwide."

Jeanette Rios came back and interjected, "There were two more companies that made proposals that were priced much higher than Amano Mcgann"

Councilman Bill Pet-

rick stated, "We won't have to replace servers if we keep this company."

One of the Council Members asked, "What kind of investment this would be?"

Rios assured the Council, "We will get our money back in 3 months guaranteed."

In conclusion, the Wilkolaski said, "Some of the towns that have these solar play stations in place include: Keansburg, Seaside Heights, Hoboken (which is expanding theirs) and Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. The new solar parking pay stations have been in use for about two years. They are programmed for up to ten languages and have larger screens to make them more user-friendly."

The resolution was moved by Councilman Bill Petrick and seconded by Fernando Irizarry. +

His response to that question has become history's most reprinted newspaper article appearing in dozens of languages, in books, movies and other editorials all over the world.

I can still remember counting the days and waiting for Santa. I knew that he came because he ate the cookies and milk that I left for him.

During my life, I have spent many of my years with younger kids. Most of them are believers, but sometimes older kids or adults try to alter their way of thinking. These people are the non-believers and have no faith in anything. They have to see and want proof.

In 1973, The New York Mets pulled off a miracle and won the National League Title. A pitcher on that team was Tug McGraw.

He coined a phrase which has carried over in Sports ever since that year. He said, "You Got to Believe."

## OPRA Requests Discussed by Residents

PERTH AMBOY - 12/9/15 the Tuesday of the following Council Meeting - Resident Ken Balut was a bit concerned about the contract for the Solar Powered Parking Pay Stations. He stated, "I heard that they're were no bids on these meters. At the League of Municipalities, there were people there you could have talked to about our meters."

Balut also wanted to know, "Why are people (the Council and others sitting up front) texting during the meetings. You are not supposed to be sitting on OPRA requests. This is what you got here."

While Balut was talking, Interim B.A. Peter Pelissier snapped Balut's photo. "At least with Joe's (Vas) administration, OPRA requests were processed promptly. You gave some people raises, but you say you are broke. You violate civil service all the time. Do what is politically correct - not politically corrupt."

City Resident Reinaldo Aviles came up to speak. He talked about meetings in general and OPRA requests. Aviles stated, "When I first started coming to the meetings, the Caucus was held on a Wednesday and the Regular Meeting was held on

week. I've never had a problem with an OPRA request. Seven days is the suggested turnaround for an answer. If it's more than seven days, then the person who filled out an OPRA request is to be informed in writing why the request is taking more than seven days."

At the 12/7/15 Caucus Meeting, Aviles read part of the N.J.S.A. Resolution. The following is part of what he read: N.J.S.A. 10:4-13. Exclusion of public; resolution; adoption; contents

No public body shall exclude the public from any meeting to discuss any matter described in [N.J.S.A. 10:4-12b] until the public body shall first adopt a resolution, at a meeting to which the public shall be admitted:

a. Stating the general nature of the subject to be discussed;

b. Stating as precisely as possible, the time when and the circumstances under which the discussion conducted in closed session of the public body can be disclosed to the public.
