## Mayor Wilda Diaz Welcomes Bridge Development Partners - \$180M Investment in Warehousing & Distribution

News Release 11/3/15

PERTH AMBOY - Mayor Wilda Diaz welcomes Bridge Development Partners, LLC to the City of Perth Amboy at the industrial groundbreaking ceremony held today to launch Phase 1 of Bridge Point ePort located at 960-1000 High Street.

The 100+ acre project, located on High Street at the Outerbridge Crossing was initially an environmentally challenged site developed by Viridian Partners, a Brown-field development company that invested \$90M in partnership with Goldman Sachs in 2013, under the guidance of the Perth Amboy Redevelopment Agency.

According to Viridian Partners, Perth Amboy is ideally situated for the growing port industry as the expansion of the Panama Canal will progressively lessen demand for inland regional distribution centers and proportionately increase demand in the Port Market.

Bridge Development Partners, LLC will be investing \$180 million for the construction of three warehousing and distribution facilities totaling 1,292,650 square feet, to be move-in-ready by August 2016. PREMIER Design + Build, LLC will lead construction of Bridge Point ePort.

"This venture marks an industrial revival in Perth Amboy. The creation of local job opportunities and the realization of new ratables are the primary goals of establishing a sustainable project that will continue to carry Perth Amboy into a prosperous future," said Wilda Diaz, Mayor and Perth Amboy Redevelopment Agency Chairperson.

"We are excited to have the opportunity to acquire such a large tract of land in one of the busiest markets in the country," said Jeff Milanaik, principal at Bridge Development Partners. "The ability to

construct 1.3 million square feet of distribution space on one property in such a mature market as New Jersey doesn't come along every day.

The project represents one of a number of coalitions in the Diaz administration that has promoted the redevelopment of underutilized land with the objective of creating quality

local jobs and improving the landscape of this historic community.

The site features approximately 1,700 linear feet of shoreline, rail access, air freight and a deep-cargo port on the Arthur Kill. The major shipping route within the

SOUTH AMBOY - Request: Recommendation from Planning Board to amend Rte. 35 North Redevelopment Plan.

Business Administrator Camille Tooker said, "SARA (South Amboy Redevelopment Agency) sent this request to the Planning Board for residential use."

Councilman Tom Reilly responded, "We need to draft an ordinance."

Attorney John Lanza told the Council what procedures they would have to follow, "We must adopt a resolution to request a redevelopment plan. We must explain what needs to be done in an ordinance."

Mayor Henry spoke next, "This area is by Delilah's Den. It will not be an entrance to or from John Street. Only emergency vehicles will be permitted to enter or leave John Street from that area."

City Attorney Jonn Lanza stated, "I will do the ordinance."

Another business item up for discussion was Shop South Amboy.

B.A. Camille Tooker stated, "We were not successful in getting sponsors for this program. The Association said they will fund 50% of the cost and the City can contribute another 50%. The total cost to the City will be \$4000. Residents will get tax credits on their property bill if they shop in the City. I met with the

Business Item No. e.) - MEU-SA-Solid Waste: The Middlesex County Utility has given us a very nominal increase. We want to renew because the rates are very good and so are the services. If we delay this, it can cost the City more."

Port of New York and New Jersey, and is identifiable as the largest port on the eastern seaboard and the third largest industrial port in America.

Bridge Point ePort will be located ½ mile from the Outer-bridge Crossing and five miles from the New Jersey Turnpike. The location offers close proximity by rail and roadway access to Newark Airport and the Ports of Newark and Elizabeth. The new industrial facility is centrally located among the 10 eastern states, between Maine to North Carolina that have formed an Offshore Wind Energy Consortium to promote the development of offshore wind energy generation.

“We look at this as an opportunity to grow businesses and

communities in the Northeast and support distribution across the USA,” states PREMIER Executive Vice President Alec Zocher. “We gladly accept the challenge presented to us—to build an industrial center that meets the demands of top companies - the kind of companies that fuel the nation’s economy.”

Tenants who choose Bridge Point ePort will benefit from a large and engaged labor force in Perth Amboy and the surrounding region. Business advantages of the industrial center will provide perks such as reduction or elimination of certain duties from its location in a Foreign Trade Zone. Additionally, incentives are built into the Economic Redevelopment and Growth Program to help fund projects. The Grow New Jersey Program can help

companies preserve and create jobs and expand operations. The site is also located within the Port Authority of NY/NJ’s Portfield Initiative and the City’s Urban Enterprise Zone.

Business tenants will be able to expand in one of three facilities:

- Building A: 354,250 sq ft.
- Building B: 220,315 sq ft.
- Building C: 718,200 sq ft.

The facilities will feature 36’ clear-height warehouse spaces, 275 truck dock positions, 8 drive-in doors and an ESFR fire protection sprinkler system. Additionally, parking lots with 703 spaces for cars and 449 spaces for trailers will be provided

Joseph Britton, a retired Detective Lieutenant in the Perth Amboy Police Department, began his career in law enforcement with the Rutgers University Police Department. He achieved the rank of Sergeant before resigning to join the Perth Amboy Police Department. After 8 years on the force in Perth Amboy, he was elevated to Detective and was assigned to the Juvenile Aid Bureau (JAB). Shortly thereafter, he was promoted to Detective Sergeant and commanded the Juvenile Aid Bureau. He served a 3 year term to the Perth Amboy Board of Education, and chaired the district’s building and renovation

program.

Joe established the Police Benevolent Association Lodge 13 Rangers. This Explorer group of 30 Perth Amboy boys aged 12 to 16, met weekly and conducted monthly camping trips. As a result of this program and many other initiatives, during his tenure in the JAB, juvenile crime in Perth Amboy was reduced by nearly fifty per cent. Many of these young men now serve as Perth Amboy Police Officers, N.J. State Troopers, County Prosecutors’ Investigators, Sheriff’s Officers and Uniformed Firefighters.

The awards ceremony is Wednesday, Oct. 28, at 5 p.m. at the NJ Carpenters Training Center, Kenilworth, New Jersey.

“We are delighted by the accomplishments of these individuals,” says Yvonne Lopez, CEO, PRAHD. “They have shown determination and a willingness to commit themselves to a program that will ultimately lead to a career in carpentry that they might never have considered before. Their success demonstrates that this program and our re-

lationship with the New Jersey Carpenters Apprentice and Educational Fund has been a success. For that reason, we have decided to renew our partnership, which will create even more opportunities for area residents to enter into the pre-apprenticeship program.”

“These individuals are glowing examples of the talent and willingness to succeed by completing more than 100 hours of technical training,” says Ridgeley Hutchinson, executive director, NJCTF.

The seven trainees will receive a \$100 award for each 100 hours of completed training in a special program developed by the New Jersey Carpenters Apprentice Training Program. In addition to the stipend, participants who have completed 200 hours of the training will receive a new leather tool apron equipped with the essential tools of the trade.

The partnership with PRAHD, The New Jersey Carpenters Apprentice Training and Education Fund and

the Carpenter Contractor Trust NY/NJ began in November 2014, to offer career opportunities in carpentry to interested qualified applicants from the area.

The applicants who expressed an interest in becoming a carpenter were referred to the pre-apprentice program by PRAHD and then must complete 400 hours of carpentry training before transitioning to the full carpenters apprentice training program. Pre-apprenticeship allows candidates to participate in a segment of the training program in the evenings while they decide if the carpentry trade is the right career choice for them.

“It has proven successful because it allows the candidate to train with a minimum impact on their current lifestyle while they are guided through the training and decision-making process,” says Hutchinson.

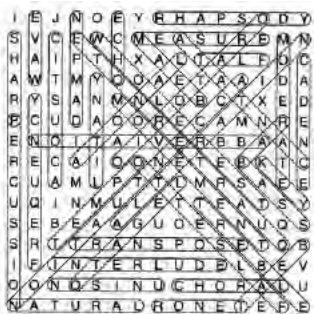

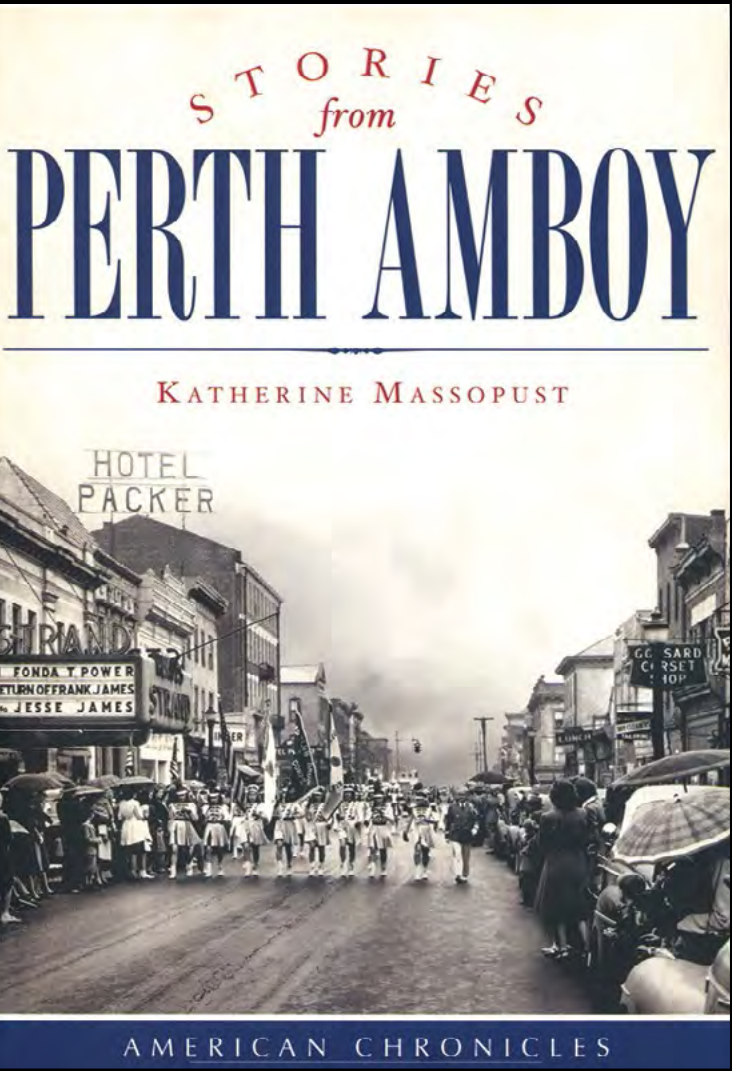

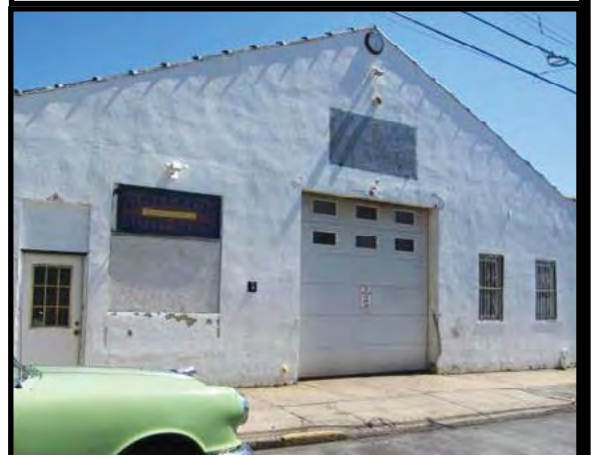
