Vitale & Coughlin Announce Clean Communities Grants for the 19th Legislative District

Funds go to Counties & Municipalities for Litter Cleanups & Improve Quality of Life in New Jersey Communities

Press Release 6/8/17 TRENTON - Senator Joseph Vitale and Assemblyman Craig J. Coughlin announced today the award of New Jersey Clean Communities grants to municipalities in the 19th Legislative District to conduct litter cleanup and beautification efforts.

Municipalities in the 19th District were awarded \$365,454 in grants which included \$170,727 for Woodbridge Township, \$75,329 for Sayreville Borough, \$65,820 for Perth Amboy City, \$15,604 for South Amboy City and \$37,974 for Carteret Borough. In addition, Middlesex County will receive \$98,527.

"This funding is important to our communities as it helps to keep them clean and maintain their beauty while improving the quality of life for our residents," said Senator Vitale (D-Middlesex). "A clean community not only helps the environment but also helps to maintain the value of properties in our municipalities."

Activities funded by the grants include cleanups of storm water systems that can disperse trash into streams, rivers and bays; volunteer cleanups of public properties; adoption and enforcement of local anti-littering ordinances; beach cleanups; public information and education programs; and purchases of litter collection equipment, litter receptacles, recycling bins, anti-litter signs and supplies to remove graffiti.

"Clean communities are important for municipalities and counties to maintain their towns clear of litter that pollutes our roads, parks, water and neighborhoods," said Coughlin (D-Middlesex) "These grants are especially important to local residents who take pride in their commu-

The New Jersey Clean Communities Council, Inc. oversees the reporting requirements for the program. The allocations to municipalities are based on the number of housing units and miles of municipally owned roadways within each municipality.

Municipalities and counties must file statistical reports with the New Jersey Clean Communities Council, Inc. every grant year. Statistical reports track the expenditure of funds and the progress of local programs.

Now in its 13th consecutive year, the Clean Communities Council oversees the implementation of litter abatement programs in 558 municipalities and 21 counties, collects statistical reports, maintains a data base of information that tracks local programs, and implements a statewide program of public information and education that targets Clean Communities coordinators, schools, and the general public. The Clean Communities Council also administers New Jersey's Adopt-a-Beach and Adopt-a-Highway programs.

Perth Amboy Police Officers Participate in Torch Run

PERTH AMBOY - 4 Police Officers from Perth Amboy participated in the Special Olympic Torch Run called the "Flame of Hope." This year was the 34th Annual Law Enforcement Torch Run. Lt. Joseph Sulikowski is shown with the torch in his hand. Alongside him are Officers Danny Gonzalez, Special I Officer Luis Almanzar and Special II Officer Joe Holland. Holland had retired from the PAPD after 25 years of service and came back to the Force as a Special II Officer.

The Amboy Guardian had a chance to speak to Officer Holland about his participation in this run. He stated, "This year's run began at 4:45 a.m. on Friday, June 9, 2017 from Island Beach State Park. The 4 Officers from Perth Amboy who participated waited on the Sayreville side of the Victory Bridge to receive the torch from the participants from the Sayreville Police Department. All 4 of us were able to run with the torch on our route. After crossing over the Victory Bridge, we made a right hand turn onto Smith Street, then continued and made a left-hand turn onto State Street and then another left

hand turn onto Fayette Street to finish the run at Shop Rite, Perth Amboy. There, we were met by the top executives of Shop Rite and were presented with commendations for our participation. I participated in 17 Torch Runs and I am the oldest participant. The only year that I missed was in 2011 due to injury. I like to get up around 5:45 a.m. in the morning to run. I participate in local runs if my schedule permits. I did a Frog Hollow Run (in South Amboy) 2 years ago. In the 1980's, I participated in a full mile race for a fundraiser. The YMCA also used to have 3 mile runs in the 1980's called "Shape Up Amboy." I've also participated in 2.5 mile runs that St. Mary' Church used to have."

The Torch Run is held nationwide. According to www. letr.org: The mission of the Law Enforcement Torch Run is to raise awareness for the Special Olympics movement. So far, the LETR has raised over \$600 million for the Special Olympics.



Recognizing that bridge resiliency is essential to safe and reliable operations along the North Jersey Coast Line (NJCL), the Raritan River Bridge Replacement project will replace the existing swing bridge that carries NJ TRANSIT's NJCL trains over the Raritan River between Perth Amboy, NJ, and South Amboy, NJ. The new bridge will be on an alignment adjacent to the existing bridge, which suffered damage in 2012 during Superstorm Sandy. Built in 1908, the Raritan River Bridge is the sole rail link for 17 of the 20 stations on the NJCL to the major job centers of Newark and Jersey City in New Jersey and the New York City borough of Manhattan. It carries almost 10,000 NJ TRANSIT customers daily and moves two million tons of freight annually via Conrail.

The document has been prepared in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) of 1969, Section 106, of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, Section 4(f) of the U.S. Department of Transportation Act of 1966, and all applicable regulations including: Council on Environmental Quality regulations at 40 CFR 1506.6; FTA regulations under 23 CFR 771.119(d); Executive Order 12898 on Environmental Justice; Executive Order 11988 on Floodplain Management; and U.S. DOT Order 5650.2 on Floodplain Management and Protection.





This Week in World War II 75 Years Ago

U.S. Army Air Forces B-24 Liberator bombers, flying from airfields near Benghazi, Libya, bomb the heavily defended Ploiești oil fields in Romania on June 12. In Libya, the retreating British, being pushed by Rommel's Germans, are only 15 miles from the Tobruk defensive perimeter. German submarine U-202 lands four German saboteurs on the beach at Amagansett, Long Island, about 115 miles east of New York City. Their mission is to sabotage economic targets within the U.S. and to spread a wave of terror by planting explosives in public places.

On June 13, President Franklin Roosevelt issues Executive Order 9182, creating the Office of Strategic Services (for intelligence) and the Office of War Information (for propaganda). In North Africa, British and South African troops begin to evacuate the Gazala Line. German submarine U-157 is depth charged and sunk northeast of Havana, Cuba, by U.S. Coast Guard cutter USCGC Thetis.

In Libya, British positions have become untenable and Gen. Claude Auchinleck, commander-in-chief, Middle East, based in Cairo, on June 14 orders British Eighth Army Commander Gen. Neil Ritchie to withdraw from all forward positions. In Bridgeport, Connecticut, the General Electric Company releases to the Army its new M1 shoulder-fired rocket launcher, commonly referred to as the "bazooka."

Rommel's 21st Panzer Division reaches Sidi Rezegh, Libya, on June 15. In Washington, D.C., exiled King George II of Greece addresses the U.S. Congress.

Two British convoys heading for Malta both suffer heavy losses on June 16. One turns back to Alexandria without delivering any cargo, while the other makes it to Malta, but with only two of the six original supply ships surviving the voyage. German submarine U-584 lands a second team of four saboteurs at Ponte Vedra Beach, Florida, south of Jacksonville. These four are to link up with the team landed in New York on June 12 and cause mayhem. However, two of the New York team decide to renege on their participation and they inform the FBI of the plans. All eight men are arrested on June 27 and no sabotage takes place. After a trial, six of the eight are executed; the two who cooperated with the government are given jail terms.


After almost two weeks of a punishing artillery barrage against Sevastopol, German infantry on June 17 begins fighting its way into the city. In Tokyo, Prime Minister Hideki Tojo is shot in the arm by a would-be assassin — a Korean nationalist — who in turn is shot and killed by Japanese police. The British withdraw from Sidi Rezegh, Ed Duda and El Adem, Libya. President Roosevelt signs a bill raising the minimum pay of servicemen to \$50 per month. The first issue of "Yank, the Army Weekly" magazine makes its debut, with a cover price of 5 cents.

On June 18, Tobruk, Libya — garrisoned mainly by the 2nd South African Infantry Division, commanded by Gen. Hendrik Klopper — is surrounded by Rommel's Afrika Korps. Some Allied troops are forced to pull back into western Egypt as Axis forces reach Kambut, 50 miles east of Tobruk. In New York, the U.S. Army establishes the Manhattan Engineering District as part of the Manhattan Project, the goal of which is developing nuclear weapons.
